

Ping-Klang!



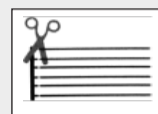
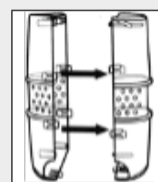
Watch out!
Or all the marbles
will fall!

Contents

1 tube, 21 sticks, 20 marbles.

Assembly

1. Snap the left and right halves of the tube together.
2. Cut the plastic rods from the frames. Use safety scissors.



Note: Adult assembly supervision recommended.

Setting up

1. Set the tube on a flat surface.
2. Insert the sticks into the tube: Put one end of the stick through a hole and push it through to a hole on the other side. Place sticks randomly so they crisscross in different directions.
3. Once the sticks are in place, load the marbles by dropping them through the opening at the top of the tube.
4. Marbles will lie on top of the web of sticks. If any falls through onto the bottom of the tube, just reload them until all the marbles rest on top of the sticks.

Let's play

1. Choose a player to go first; the game will then pass to the left.
2. On each turn:
 - a. Turn the tube around so that the tube is facing you. Take care not to move the marbles!
 - b. Pick any stick and carefully pull it all the way out of the tube, trying not to move the marbles and cause them to drop.

Note: The first stick you touch is the stick you must pull out, but you can also hold the tube steady with one hand.
 - c. After removing the stick, set it aside. If any marbles fall during your turn, pick them up in front of you.
3. It's now the next player's turn to repeat steps a, b, and c.

Note: A player's turn is not complete until the next player touches the tube to spin or a stick. Any marbles falling before the next player touches the tube or stick add to the first player's score.
4. When all the marbles have fallen out of the tube, each player counts the number of marbles in front of them.

Winning

The player with the fewest marbles wins!
