



Be the first to guess who it is!

## Contents

2 game units, 3 sheets of character cards, 2 sets of plastic frames, 4 scoring markers.

## Assembly

1. Carefully remove all the plastic frames from the carriers. You can use scissors to make it easier.
2. Attach the plastic frames to the boards, there are 24 frames for each board.
3. Cut the pre-cut cards from two sheets, and carefully insert them into each frame.
4. Cut the cards from the third sheet. These cards are the ones to guess who the character is.
5. Push one scoring marker into position on each board.

**Note:** Adult assembly supervision recommended.

## Setting up

1. Each player chooses a board. The frames on the board should all be upright. This allows the player to see all the cards.
2. Shuffle the cards.
3. Each player chooses one card, taking care that the other player does not see it, and places it in the questioning slot. Now, you're ready to play.

### Let's play

1. The youngest player will go first. Remember, you are trying to guess who is in your opponent's card.
2. The question that you ask must be one that can be answered with a YES or a NO. For example, "Does the person wear glasses? If YES, you can flip over any character without glasses.
3. Now it is the turn of the second player to ask questions.
4. Continue to ask questions until you know how to reveal your opponent's card, taking turns.

**Note:** You can't ask if someone is a boy or a girl until you have

## Winning

- If you guess who is in your opponent's card, you win the round! However, if your guess is wrong, your opponent wins the round.
- The winner of the round moves his point marker up 1 place and starts over for the next round.
- The overall winner is the first player to win 5 rounds!
